



Bright Young Things Information

- Classes run every Saturday during term time from 10.15am until 11.45am, 12.15 to 1.45 pm or 2.15 to 3.45 pm. We do not break for half term. The classes are held at Gorse Covert Community Centre, Maxwell Drive, Loughborough LE11 4RZ.
 - The school practices a zero tolerance policy with regards to bullying. Bullying behaviour, of any kind, will result in the offending child being excluded from class.
 - Classes may be fairly physical, and so we may have to ask students to remove any jewellery which we deem to be potentially dangerous. Please ensure that all those attending are wearing loose, comfortable clothing, and soft soled shoes suitable for movement (e.g. tracksuit bottoms, trainers/jazz shoes etc).
 - Photographs – The school may occasionally take photos/video during classes/performances to use for future publicity material in the local press etc. Signature of the Registration Form means that you give your consent for your child to be photographed. If you have any concerns regarding this please do not hesitate to speak to Nick when you return your Registration Form.
 - The school cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to personal possessions. Any valuables should be left with parents/guardian at the start of the day.
 - The parent/guardian must leave valid contact telephone numbers on the Registration Form, and must be contactable during school time.
 - We will be having a short break during the morning. Please feel free to bring drinks/snacks. Squash is provided. A tuck shop is open during break.
 - Fees are payable termly in advance, either by full payment on registration or by instalments (details of instalments available on request). Fees are non-refundable.
- We require 2 weeks notice or payment in lieu of notice if your child leaves Bright Young Things at any time apart from the end of the school year in July.
